Dear Chair Dorsey,

The Arlington Chamber of Commerce requests that the County Board defer the request to advertise public hearings on the modifications of bonus density and height provisions. Upon first review of the proposal, there are many elements—particularly those related to housing affordability—that strike us as positive changes. However, there are other elements that have broad implications, with which we are still grappling. We believe that the best result will come from considering all of the proposed amendments together, hence our request to defer the entire advertisement for a month.

The potential impacts of the proposed changes are complex, and require study and review to understand completely. However, many in the business and development community first learned of the proposal when it was introduced at the Zoning Committee meeting on September 17. County staff has engaged with the business community since, including with our Government Affairs & Economic Development Committee yesterday. But we have just started to process these exchanges, ask questions, and form responses. A brief delay in the advertisement will give the community time to provide feedback and the County staff time to improve the proposal based on this feedback before bringing it forward for a County Board action.
