Guidelines to consider for the safety of staff:

- Prepared food can be accepted only from certified restaurants and catering companies.
- Items must be individually packaged, boxed and labeled.
- Items such as open trays of food or large containers (i.e. family-style foods, shared apps) will not be accepted.
- Homemade food cannot be accepted.

Food that is from kitchen approved by the health department will be accepted for the safety of staff. This should encompass most local restaurants. Every meal does need to be individually packaged with the exception of pizza. Items like burritos, individually portioned BBQ meals, single serving salads etc. can be accepted. Items like shared platters, apps, dips or things that lead to multiple staff consuming one item cannot be accepted.
