In light of the historic health and economic crisis that COVID-19 has caused in the Commonwealth, we would like to first thank you for your leadership and unwavering commitment to the health and safety of our citizens.

On behalf of the Alexandria, Arlington, Greater Reston, Loudoun, Northern Virginia, Prince William, and Tysons Chambers of Commerce, and our over 5,500 member businesses combined, we join with the Virginia Chamber in asking that you to consider conforming the Virginia state income tax filing deadline to the new Federal deadline of July 15th 2020, as at least 40 other states have recently done.
